



Tonight sees the running of the South Australian Solo Championship, which is the first round of the World Championship Series. The first six placegetters from tonight's title will qualify for the Southern Zone Final in two weeks when they will meet the top six Victorian and the top four Western Australian riders.

John Boulger, after a brilliant performance last week, will be attempting to equal the legendary Jack Young's record of nine State Titles at Rowley Park. The only other multiple winners are Bob Leverenz (three times) and Jack Scott who won in 1965 and 1967.

Our second major attraction tonight is the South Australian Qualifying Round for the Australian Speedcar Championship, to be held in Perth next month. At present Phil Herreen is 15 points clear of Trev. McIntosh, who is 2 points ahead of Greg Anderson, then Rex Hodgson in fourth place, 26 points behind Phil. Tonight's main race will decide the two official South Australian cars, although entries will be accepted from other competitors who are keen enough to make the trip across the Nullarbor.

Congratulations to Bill Wigzell, who ran a very close second to Steve Brazier at the Australian Sprintcar Championship in Warrnambool last Monday night. We've been hearing stories about top drivers from all over Australia, but "The Wizard" can still put in the performance when the chips are down.

Anyhow! It's time for more action, so sit back, light up a Winfield 25's and enjoy the Racing.

AND QUALIFYING ROUND FOR THE SOUTHERN ZONE FINAL

Points are scored as follows:

First: 3 points; Second: 2 points; Third: 1 point.

At the conclusion of 20 heats, if two or more riders have scored the same number of points, run-off heats will be held to decide positions 1 to 3.

Helmet colours will denote starting positions — Red: position 1, inside of track; Blue: position 2; White, position 3; Yellow: position 4, outside lane.

The programme as set down will give each rider 5 starts and the opportunity to compete against every other rider. Each rider has been programmed to start from every starting position at least once.

Riders will be excluded for tape breaking or exceeding the two minute limit. If a rider is excluded prior to the start of a race, he will be replaced by one of the reserves.

If a rider falls or has mechanical failure during the race or is excluded after the race has commenced, the reserve will not be used, only the remaining riders will re-start.
