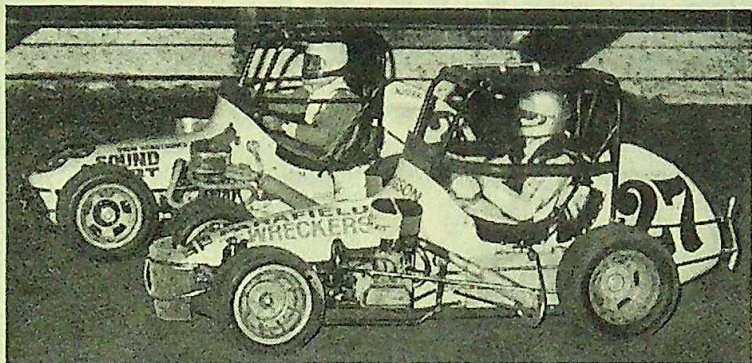

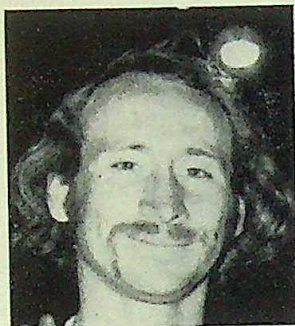

with Rob Lock

JOHN BOULGER (S.A.)

Eight times S.A. Champion; twice Australian Champion ('70 & '73); Captain of Australia's World Team Cup winning side; World finalist and winner of last year's Southern Zone final. John was third in the recent S.A. Solo Championship after being excluded in the final and will be out to make amends tonight.



ROB MAXFIELD (S.A.)

The new S.A. Solo Champion; Rob won with a 15 points maximum. His powerful style of riding keeps his fans cheering and he will be out to prove tonight he is S.A.'s best. He finished fourth in last year's Southern Zone final.



LLOYD CROSS (W.A.)

The Solo find of 1978, Lloyd made it through to the Australasian final in New Zealand after stirring performances at Rowley (Southern Zone final) and Brisbane (Australian final). Third in the 1977/78 Australian title after losing a run-off for second to Herne. Equal top qualifier from W.A. for tonight's final.

TIM NUNAN (Vic.)

Another Mildura rider with British League experience, riding for Second Division Stoke. With Mountford finished third in the National League Pairs Championship and scored 11 points in the Stoke "Pride of the Potteries". Has had two international starts for Australia against England scoring seven points on both occasions.

ROD HUNTER (Vic.)

Impressed with a fine nine point gain at last year's Southern Zone final and is another of the Mildura flyers. Rode in England last season for Second Division Newcastle.

Second in the S.A. Solo Championship and winner of the Jimmy Gavros Memorial this year. In superb form this season, he has ridden in England and in fact won the Second Division Riders Championship.

JOHN "YAPPA" WILLIAMS (Vic.)

Rode in 1976/77 Southern Zone final and scored seven points to make it through to the Australian final in Brisbane. Rode in England for Second Division Newport and in Australia is based at Mildura.

The Mildura flyer is co-holder of the 3-lap record at Rowley and won the first two Southern Zone finals (both with 15 point maximums). He is a former Australian Champion and has made two World Final appearances. Injury has severely cut into his career the last two seasons. 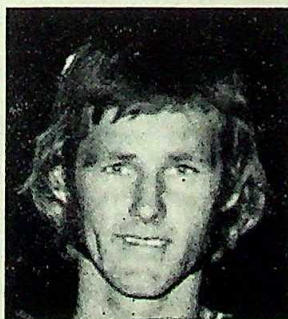
GLYN TAYLOR (W.A.)

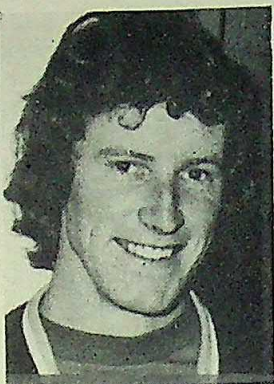

KIM AMUNDSEN (S.A.)

Started the season in fine form and is a top scratch rider; fifth qualifier from S.A. who has ridden for Second Division Workington but did not tour last year. Represented Australia against England this year at the Rowley Test.



ROD NORTH (Vic.)

Shepparton rider who rules the roost at Wattle Park Speedway.



PETER COLLINS (S.A.)

The final S.A. qualifier who rode consistently in his first major event.

ROB & ROSS TOWNSON (W.A.)

Brother combination who finished third and fourth in the Western Zone final. Ross travelled to the U.K. and rode for Second Division Barrow and made second half appearances at Halifax. Partnered McKeon to third in Scottish Pairs Championship.
